

Word from the
Pastor

The season of Epiphany follows the Christmas season in the liturgical church year. The stories told in worship on the day of Epiphany (January 6) and the Sundays following until Lent are stories which manifest God's presence and blessing in the person of Jesus. Each of these stories reveal Jesus as the blessed one of God in a different way - slowly revealing to us

God's full manifestation in the life and ministry of Jesus.

This slow unveiling of Jesus' identity and vocation is intentionally built into the liturgical church year. These weeks move us through a variety of understandings about Jesus. They invite us to consider who Jesus is for us, and what might still be revealed to us. They also remind us that we, too, are works in progress. God is still forming us in our identity and calling us to vocations in the church, our homes, and the world.

As we begin to do ministry together, we will learn many new things about each other. We will learn what works and what doesn't work. We'll learn what is important to keep the same, and what we'd like to try to do differently. We will experiment with different ways of speaking, acting, worshipping, and doing ministry. Don't panic! I am not suggesting that I - or anyone - has plans to make major changes at CLC. Still, anytime a new pastor comes in to a congregation, subtle changes happen, and it is good to expect these.

It is also important for you to know that you do not have to like the changes. Whenever that happens, you are welcome to share your preferences with me. As your pastor, I will always welcome your thoughts, opinions, celebrations, and concerns about any part of our ministry together. Direct communication is key to successful ministry. Thus, if you ever have a question, or you notice something that doesn't seem right, or you want to try something new, please come and talk to me! If you don't feel comfortable talking to me by yourself, bring a friend. I will always listen. I will always let you know how I intend to respond. However, because ministry is a mutual endeavor, I do not respond to anonymous concerns. We build our congregation and its ministry together. CLC already does this well through the Common Life Table (and, I imagine, other ways I haven't learned about yet).

I continue to be excited by all that I'm learning and experiencing at CLC. I am delighted to serve as your pastor. I am confident that God is continuing to reveal for us our identity and our vocation. May God bless us on the journey!
