Christ Lutheran Church has a congregational goal to develop ministry in support of children and families! The Goal states that *CLC will continue to nurture a community where children, families, young adults and leaders are being formed in faith in God through practices of worship, caring, education, service, and fellowship together.*

### How are we moving on this goal?

A “design team” is meeting to focus this goal into key action areas. Then it will develop a job description for Youth and Family Ministry at CLC to fill the

position left by Kathy Bartosz. A special forum that invites your hopes, thoughts, and ideas is scheduled for June 10 and June 17, immediately following worship in Fellowship Hall.

### We welcome children into worship this summer!

Look for the Kids Korner right inside the center entrance to the worship space. Children can take books from the Little Free Library, a children’s bulletin for coloring and word puzzles, and an activity for busy hands. Place them in a basket and carry them to your seat!

**What’s a Little Free Library?** It’s this simple: children take a book and return a book! The Little Free Library was crafted by our own Building and Grounds Supervisor, Bob Brija, and is situated right inside the center entrance to the worship space. The books in the Little Free Library tell a story of our faith for children. Each Sunday, a child can pick out a book to take into worship, OR, take home after worship, OR both! It’s free! Take a book! Return the same book or a different book! Share the story of God’s Good News! That’s how it works.

**What about Children’s Church?** Children’s Church on Sundays in summer invites children to leave the worship space right after the Children’s message, go into the Fireside Room for an age appropriate message and activity, and come back into worship during the offering. On some Sundays during the summer season there WILL be Children’s Church. On other Sundays there will not be Children’s Church. This will be announced at the start of worship each Sunday. The Busy Baskets will be available EACH Sunday.

Prepare to welcome special a Children’s Message each Sunday during the Summer weeks. Thank you in advance to the messengers, Mary Satchwell, Bonnie Bucholz, Jon Ball, Steven Dickens, and Pastor Dale.

The nursery will continue to be available and staffed during worship too.

At Christ Lutheran Church we place importance on making sure our Church Nursery is a safe and inviting place staffed by capable, qualified and loving attendants. We are in need of someone who can provide occasional back-up for our regular Sunday Attendant, Tiffany Helphingstine.

We are looking for someone 18 or over who loves children; especially those from birth to age 3, the ages of children primarily in our nursery. We require that all candidates go through Child Protection Training and are cleared through a background check with our insurance company. This job pays \$15.00 per hour.
